For nearly 55 years, the Latin American Community Center (LACC) has been a leader within Wilmington's Latino community, serving more than 7,500 individuals annually. As the largest and most trusted agency dedicated to serving the Hispanic community in Delaware, the LACC provides holistic wraparound programs and services while also advocating for low-income children, youth, and families in a bilingual, safe and culturally-appropriate environment. 2023 was a very exciting year of expansion for the LACC with the opening of our La Fiesta II Early Learning Center in Wilmington. We are excited to continue that momentum in 2024 with the opening of our La Fiesta III Early Learning Center in New Castle and the continued growth of our existing programs.

One area of growth that is especially exciting is our Minerva Marrero Hispanic Scholarship Program (MMHSP). In its inaugural year, the LACC received 40 applications and provided a combined \$25,000 in scholarships to 7 incredibly talented high school seniors to support their post-secondary education. We look forward to continuing to grow this program in 2024 to make it's second year even better than its first. August 2024 also marks the 55th anniversary of the LACC's founding. In 2023 we were finally able to bring back the Grand Ball for the first time since 2019. We are excited to continue this annual tradition while also celebrating this monumental anniversary at our 2024 Grand Ball.

We look forward to including our community partners in these two annual events. On August 3, 2024 we will celebrate the achievements of our scholarship recipients at our Minerva Marrero Hispanic Scholarship Program Award Ceremony. Then on October 11, 2024 we will close out Hispanic Heritage Month and celebrate the LACC 55th anniversary at our Annual Grand Ball

Latin American Community Center Sponsorship Package Proposal

Organization Background

The Latin American Community Center (LACC) was founded in 1969 by Puerto Rican immigrants and community leaders who sought to establish a resource center. Over the years, the LACC has transformed dramatically from a small, grassroots agency in a red brick row house to the largest Latino serving organization that serves more than 7,500 individuals annually. The LACC is a beacon of hope for many Hispanics in the local community, and a vital community anchor in Wilmington's Hilltop neighborhood, the most densely populated area in Delaware with one of the highest concentrations of children.

The LACC provides holistic wraparound programs and services as well as advocates for low-income children, youth and families in a bilingual, safe, and culturally-specific environment. More than 30 programs are offered in two strategically focused tracks: Lifelong Learning, which offers a broad spectrum of educational services, from ages 6-weeks to 18 years; and Life Empowerment, which helps low- and moderate- income (LMI) minority individuals and families achieve or re-establish self-sufficiency. In addition, with a staff of more than 100 employees from 17 countries (95% of whom are fluent in more than one language), the LACC has the highest concentration of professional bilingual and/or bicultural employees in Delaware.

We are committed to strengthening the community and fulfilling our mission. This important work would be impossible without the support we receive from government sources, local organizations and businesses, and families and individuals throughout Delaware.

Minerva Marrero Hispanic Scholarship Program

The Latin American Community Center's Minerva Marrero Hispanic Scholarship Program provides monetary scholarships for Hispanic Seniors in the State of Delaware to support their post-secondary education. The goal of the program is to open doors for Hispanic students to pursue greater opportunities, inspire pride in our people and heritage, motivate students to work hard, and encourage families to support them. The program was named after Minerva Marrero, one of the founders of the previous Hispanic Student Recognition Program. It is an honor to name this program after Minerva so that her legacy of advocating for the success of Hispanic students continues each and every day.

Award recipients of the Minerva Marrero Hispanic Scholarship Program will receive funds that are aimed to help finance their associates, bachelors or trade school tuition. In 2024 Scholarships will be awarded in 3 tiers: \$5,000, \$3,000; and \$2,000. The tier a student is eligible for is based on financial need. Recipients will be selected based on their academic achievement, community involvement and review of submitted supplementary materials.
