The Latin American Community Center's Minerva Marrero Hispanic Scholarship Program, formally known as the Hispanic Student Recognition Program (HSRP), provides monetary scholarships for Hispanic Seniors in the State of Delaware to support their post-high school education. The goal of the program is to open doors for Hispanic students to pursue greater opportunities, inspire pride in our people and heritage, motivate students to work hard, and encourage families to support them. The new iteration of this program was named after Minerva Marrero, one of the founders of the HSRP program. It is an honor to name this program after Minerva so that her legacy of advocating for the success of Hispanic students continues each and every day.

Award recipients of the Minerva Marrero Hispanic Scholarship Program will receive funds that are aimed to help finance their associates, bachelors or trade school tuition. In its inaugural year the LACC plans to award 7 scholarships, (3) \$5,000 scholarships, (2) \$3,000 scholarships, and (2) \$2,000 scholarships. Recipients will be selected based on their academic achievement, community involvement and financial need.
